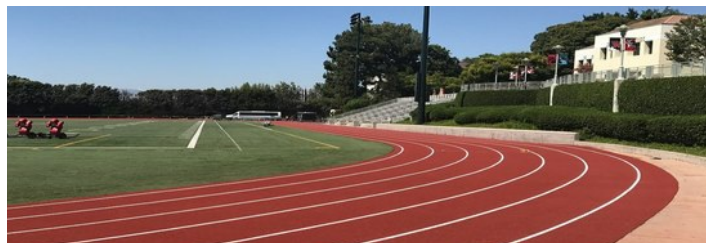
Coach of the Year Honors
