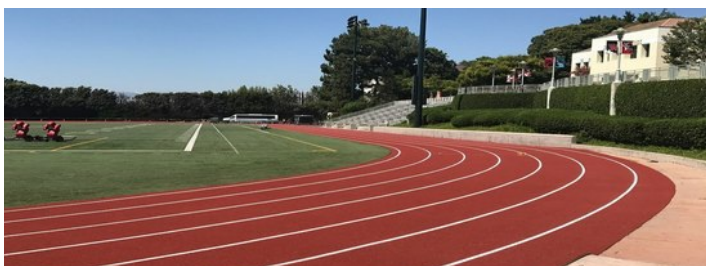
Boys Water Polo
