

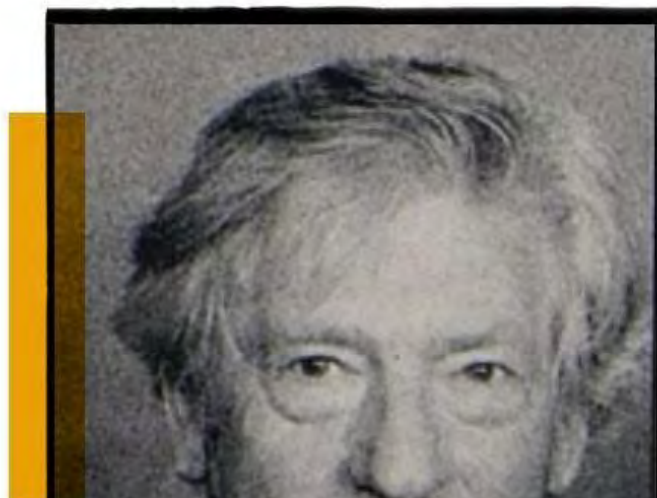


HARVARD-WESTLAKE

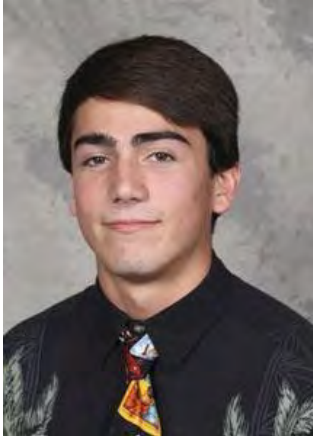

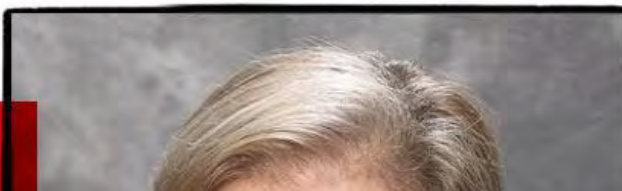


Leonard J. Sherman Ph.D., Dean of Faculty and English Teacher
